Exhibition Overview & Layout

Indusfood Manufacturing 2027 is held at Yashobhoomi - India International Convention & Expo Centre (IICC), Dwarka Sector 25, New Delhi. This is one of the most advanced convention and exhibition venues in the country.

About the Venue

Yashobhoomi is a world-class facility designed to host India's largest and most prestigious international events.

The venue features:

- The biggest Convention Centre in the country, with capacity for up to **10,000** delegates at a time.
- A Plenary Hall that can seat up to **6,000** people.
- A network of flexible spaces and covered terraces.
- **Hall 1** - the primary exhibition hall for Indusfood Manufacturing 2027.
- State-of-the-art connectivity, logistics infrastructure, and visitor amenities.

Entry & Registration Process

Indusfood Manufacturing is a premium B2B trade event with entry restricted to qualified trade professionals, processors, and industry visitors. Registration is mandatory for all attendees.

How to Register

- Visit the official event website: www.indusfoodmanufacturing.co.in
- Click on 'Visitor Registration' and complete the online registration form
- Provide your name, company name, designation, and industry segment
- Submit the form and await a confirmation email with your login credentials
- Use your registered email and password to access your visitor dashboard

Important Notes

- Visitor registration is free of charge
- Pre-registration is strongly recommended for a faster, hassle-free entry experience
- Walk-in registrations may be available on-site but are subject to availability
- For special conference sessions or workshops, pre-booking may be required and will be communicated separately
- Carry a valid government-issued photo ID on all days of the event

Visitor Badge & Accreditation

Your visitor badge is your key to accessing the exhibition, conference sessions, and networking areas. It must be worn visibly at all times within the event premises.

Collecting Your Badge

- Upon arriving at the venue, proceed to the Visitor Registration & Badge Collection counters at the designated entry points.
- Present your registration confirmation (printed or on mobile) along with a valid government-issued photo ID.
- Your badge will be printed and issued on the spot.
- Pre-registered visitors will experience faster processing at dedicated express counters.

Badge Guidelines

- Your badge is non-transferable and valid only for the registered individual.
- Wear your badge visibly on your person at all times inside the venue.
- Lost badges must be reported immediately to the Help Desk - a replacement may be issued upon identity verification.
- Badges grant access to the general exhibition floor; specific conference sessions may require separate registration or event passes.
- Do not tamper with, deface, or alter your badge in any way.

Hall & Pavilion Guide

Parking & Transportation

Yashobhoomi (IICC) is well-connected by both public transport and road. Visitors are encouraged to use Delhi Metro for a smooth and timely arrival, particularly during peak hours.

By Metro (Recommended)

- The nearest metro station is Dwarka Sector 25 on the Delhi Metro Blue Line.
- The station provides direct access to the Yashobhoomi Exhibition Centre.
- The Blue Line connects to key interchange stations including Rajiv Chowk (Central Secretariat), Dwarka, and Noida.
- Visitors are strongly encouraged to use the metro to avoid traffic congestion during the show days.

By Road

- Yashobhoomi is located at Sector 25, Dwarka, New Delhi — 110061.
- The venue is accessible via NH-48 (Delhi–Jaipur Highway) and the Dwarka Expressway.
- Ample on-site parking is available; follow signage at the venue for designated visitor parking areas.
- Shuttle services may be operational between select metro stations and the venue — check the event website for updates.

By Air

- Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI) is approximately 10–15 minutes from Yashobhoomi by road.
- Taxis, app-based cabs, and the Airport Metro Express are available from the airport.

Safety & Emergency Procedures

The safety of all visitors, exhibitors, and staff is the top priority at Indusfood Manufacturing. All attendees are requested to familiarise themselves with the safety guidelines below before entering the venue.

General Safety Rules

- Follow all instructions and signage displayed within the venue at all times.
- Do not obstruct emergency exits, aisles, or fire safety equipment.
- Keep personal belongings with you at all times and report any unattended bags to security.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the exhibition halls and convention areas.
- Consumption of alcohol is permitted only in designated zones.

In Case of Emergency

- On hearing the emergency alarm, stop all activities and calmly follow the instructions of venue staff and security personnel.

- Proceed immediately to the nearest emergency exit — exit routes are clearly marked with green signage throughout the venue.
- Do not use lifts or escalators during an evacuation.
- Assemble at the designated Emergency Assembly Points outside the venue.
- Do not re-enter the building until you receive an all-clear from venue authorities.

Medical & First Aid

- First Aid stations are located at multiple points throughout the venue - refer to the venue map or ask any staff member for directions.
- For medical emergencies, contact venue security or the Help Desk immediately.
- Emergency services: Dial 112 (All Emergency Services) | 101 (Fire) | 102 (Ambulance).

Security

- All visitors are subject to security screening at entry points.
- Prohibited items include weapons, flammable materials, and any item deemed a security risk.
- The venue has CCTV surveillance throughout - your safety is continuously monitored.

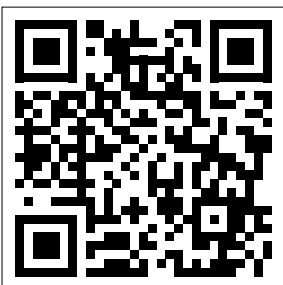
